1. Competition open to everyone, regardless of age or location
2. Entries accepted from 4:00 P.M. to 9:00P.M. FRIDAY.
3. Blooms shown in competition must be grown by exhibitor, except exhibits entered in classes 8 through 20.
4. Entry tabs with class number and variety visible and exhibitors name concealed will be furnished.
5. The number of entries in each class is not limited, but only one aware per exhibitor may be given in each class. No exhibit can be entered in more than 1 class.
6. No awards will be made unless exhibits are considered sufficiently meritis by the judge.
7. The Show Committee will not assume responsibility for injury to exhibits or loss of containers.
8. Exhibits may not be removed before the end of the Show at **4:30 P.M. SUNDAY.**
9. All exhibits must be claimed by 5:30 P.M. SUNDAY unless other arrangements are made.
10. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each class'
11. Cash prizes of \$3 for 1st place, \$2 for 2nd place and \$1 for 3rd place will be awarded in the Marigold Classes of 1 through 11.
12. Classes 1 through 7 can be shown in bottles, as only the bloom is judged. Arrangements are judged on design of materials, containers and color.
